CHILDREN'S PENNY PARADE ON WEDNESDAY

Established twenty four years ago, the annual children's project here at camp is to raise funds for the Children's Ministry Building. In recent years, our Children's Building has allowed us to grow in year-round ministry through many different programs. EVERY PENNY COUNTS is our newest campaign to raise money for the final portion of this project – an attached pavilion. This outdoor space will give us even more room to grow.

The children will again *March the Mile* on Wednesday evening, gathering offerings as they strive to continue to promote this project to the camp. All parade participants should meet at the Children's Ministry Building entrance area at 6:15 on Wednesday evening. Children of all ages are encouraged to attend, bringing banners and signs proclaiming the value this project has created for expanded camp ministries. The parade will begin promptly at 6:30 prior to the evening service. Every mile of pennies = \$840 and helps to secure funds to finish the building.

Note: For the safety of all who are in the parade, please adhere to the golf cart regulations. We encourage carts to be decorated and in the parade, but only the registered driver is permitted to be behind the wheel. **No bicycles, scooters, etc. or four wheelers are permitted to be ridden in the parade.** We ask that for the safety of the children, no candy is thrown at the children or from golf carts.

A CLOSER LOOK: CHILDREN'S BIBLE HOUR

Children's Bible Hour meets in two age level sessions each morning at the Children's Ministry Building. An exciting time of singing and Bible lessons paves the way for the gospel message to be shared. This year's theme is **Come Follow Me! Becoming One of Jesus' Super Followers** - the kids will look at several people in the Bible who followed Jesus and set an example for us to become a "super follower" of Jesus, too. Each day children will be placed on a team and gain points for saying their Bible memory verse, bringing their Bible, completing their God-sightings paper, and bringing offering.

Immediately then notify security, the first aid staff or the office personnel who will then enact the emergency medical response plan, to open the gate and direct the ambulance to your location. Please be prepared to provide your complete location including a cottage #, RV site# (west, north, east), Dorm# and room#. If you are staying at a cottage, please be sure that all occupants know what number it is.

Parents, grandparents, and others who are responsible for children age 5-12 here on the grounds, please be sure that your children are registered and know the location they are staying at: cottage#, RV site# (west, north, east), dorm#/room#. This will assist the Children's Ministry team greatly when needing to locate a family member. Toddlers that will be attending Preschool Corner or Mission Possible are to be registered also.
