## THE MINISTRY

of Mahaffey Camp

Mahaffey Camp was founded in 1894. In its 125+ years, Mahaffey Campers have listened to a gifted list of Bible Teachers. These have included most of the presidents of The C&MA, a



generous sprinkling of college administrators and faculty, and a long list of other notables. The missionary voices have literally encompassed the world in their representation.



Today, Mahaffey Family Camp is the second largest gathering of pastors, Christian workers, and lay people in the denomination of The Christian & Missionary Alliance,

surpassed only by the churchwide General Council. Attendance each summer at the ten day Family Camp held in July is between 1,500 - 2,500 people.

Mahaffey Camp also offers youth camps throughout the summer for children and teens in grades 1-12. The action packed camps are filled with hands-on activities, a well-rounded spiritual impact, and friendship building experiences.

Mahaffey Camp is situated in the midst of one of Western PA's most beautiful mountain areas, surrounded by dense forest with sparkling mountain streams which are inhabited by several species of



game fish. The woodlands provide the home for white-tailed deer, black bear, wild turkey and other forms of game as well as opportunities for hiking, bird watching and photography.

The nearby Susquehanna River is well suited for fishing, river wading, canoeing and kayaking. Modern highways make the facilities easily accessible. Two state parks are within short driving distance providing hiking trails, swimming, boating, and fishing.

Located on the West Branch of the Susquehanna River along Route 219 in rural Clearfield County, Mahaffey Camp consists of 45 acres. Its facilities include two tabernacles for worship, a modern dining hall, Children's Ministry Worship Center, two dormitories, two long houses, twenty chalets, three RV areas and nearly 200 privately owned cottages. There is a paved basketball court, sand volleyball court, a gaga dodgeball pit, a multi-use soccer field, a playground, and two nature-based playspaces.



Expansion continues at Mahaffey Camp, providing a spiritual retreat center to guest groups of various sizes and interests. Accommodations in renovated housing are available for groups up to 200 participants during the fall, winter, and spring seasons. Meeting spaces are available in the Dining

Hall and Bookstore facility. Additionally, the Children's Ministry Center offers an indoor recreational space, as well as a separate meeting space in the upstairs Mezzanine. A gazebo and multiple fire pit locations are also available for group usage. Mahaffey Camp and Conference Center is available to serve you with the following ministry opportunities:
