FIRST AID STATION (located at the Welcome Center): 9:00-11:30am, 1:30-3:30pm, and 6:30-8:00pm. The after-hours emergency number for first aid on call is 814-592-6814. Please only use this number in an emergency after hours. **In the event of an emergency** where an ambulance is required, please dial 911, providing the address of Mahaffey Camp, Rt. 219, Mahaffey PA. Immediately then notify security, the first aid staff or the office personnel who will then enact the emergency medical response plan, to open the gate and direct the ambulance to your location. Please be prepared to provide your complete location.

NO PARKING will be permitted from the bridge to the store area. This area is blocked off from all traffic, including vehicles and golf carts. **Please encourage everyone to practice bridge safety.** No one should be walking along the outside of the railing or throwing items off of the bridge.
