From the Director/Developer

It's hard to believe that another year of Family Camp has already come and gone. It has been an incredible blessing to spend this year's camp alongside you - worshipping, fellowshipping, and growing together in Christ. I pray that you have been refreshed because of your time here. I hope that you have experienced genuine life change, that God has spoken to you through the words of our speakers. And I hope that you are returning home with a renewed focus on your spiritual walk with the Lord. I challenge you not to let Family Camp 2023 fade into a memory, but to consider it a catalyst in your life, an inspiration to return home and share the things you've learned with those in your community.

There is a great deal of work that goes into the preparation, facilitation, and clean up after the conclusion of Family Camp, and I am so grateful for all the volunteers who have given their time and effort to make these 10 days run so smoothly.

I am also incredibly grateful for the support that you have shown to our ministries during your time here. The Golf Tournament raised **\$1,373.95** for the Youth Camp Scholarship Fund, and the Penny Parade raised **\$6,438.10** for the construction of a Children's Building Pavilion.

Please be in prayer about whether God is leading you to continue supporting our ministries. One thing has become very clear in our recent retreats and camps: we are a growing ministry in need of more housing and program space. As I mentioned in my Tuesday night presentation, we have had to turn youth campers away this summer because we are out of beds. We've also reached maximum attendance in retreats like REPLENISH and Men's Link this year. And if you've been to the Children's Ministries during this year's Family Camp, you've seen how much we need the additional space that a Pavilion could provide.

As a non-profit ministry, we rely on your provision to continue and expand our ministries.
