MAIN TAB SPEAKER REV. TERRY SMITH

Rev. Terry Smith was appointed as vice president for Church Ministries with The Christian and Missionary Alliance and began serving in this role on December 1, 2017.

Terry has served with the C&MA since 1981. He pastored Alliance churches in Florida and in Pennsylvania as well as serving in the role of church-planting director in three districts. He was elected superintendent of the Eastern PA district in August 2014. Terry also served on the C&MA Board of Directors prior to being appointed as vice president for Church Ministries in December 2017.

A graduate of Toccoa Falls College, Terry also holds a master's degree from Crown College. He is the author of <u>Changing Course: Leading Older Churches in a New Direction</u>. Terry has been married to Ruth since 1977. They have two married adult sons and five grandchildren.

Notice about pets and bicycles: For the safety of all attending Family Camp, bicycles, scooters, etc. are not permitted. Also not permitted during Family Camp are pets. A complete list of the rules and regulations are available with your Family Camp billing or at the Welcome Center. Cottage owners are reminded to inform all occupants of your cottage concerning the regulations which are in effect year round.

Dumpsters are located throughout the campground for your household refuse disposal. Please do not put cardboard, wood, building supplies, furniture, branches, etc. in the dumpster. During Family Camp there is no curbside pickup for leaves, branches or garbage. Leaves and branches may be placed at the mulch pile. Please do not dump items at the soccer field hill.

First Aid services are provided at the Welcome Center on a limited basis when personnel are available: 9:00-11:30am, 1:30-3:30pm, 6:30-8:00pm. Nearby Urgent Care centers as well as Emergency Room services are located both in Punxsutawney and DuBois.
