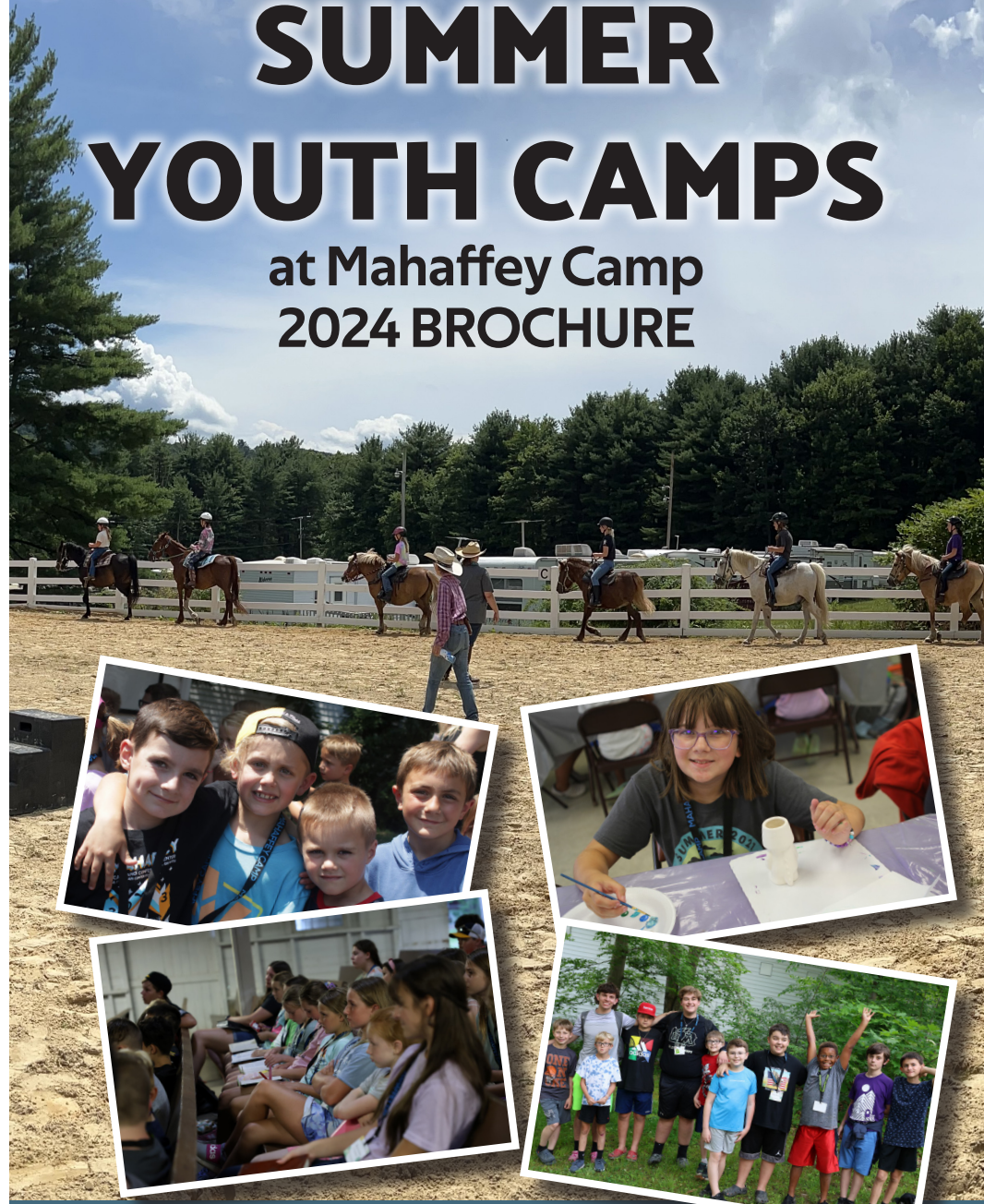

# DETAILS TO KNOW



## Camper Age Guidelines:

Campers may choose a camp based on the grade level they have just completed, or the one they will enter in the fall.

## What to Bring:

Bible, pen/pencil, snack shop money, clothing suitable for camp (including a jacket and modest swim suit), sneakers, flashlight, soap, sun screen, towels, reusable water bottle, toothbrush, toothpaste, bedding and pillow for a single bed, and other personal hygiene items. Please label all camper items (including prescription medications in a labeled Ziploc bag).

Some camps require specific items. A full list of what to pack will be sent to you in your email confirmation two weeks prior to camp.

## Prohibited Items:

The following items are not permitted at camp: cellphones, radios/cd players, iPods, laser pointers, computers, tablets or other electronic devices, fireworks, drugs/tobacco (including e-cigarettes), alcohol or any other illegal substances, knives, or other weapons.

*These items are all prohibited at youth camps and are subject to confiscation.*

**Early Registration Discount:**  
on or before April 12

**Late Fee:** after May 14

**Deadline to Register for All Camps:** Wednesday the week prior to camp (4 days before camp starts)



## Registration Info:

Registration is from 6:30-7:30 PM on the first day of camp. No evening meal is served on Sunday, but campers will be treated to snack time. All camps (except Young Explorers) conclude on Friday at 2 PM. Recognition programs are held for Young Explorers, Kids, Horse, Basketball, and Creative Arts Camps - further details will be included in the emailed camper confirmation letter.

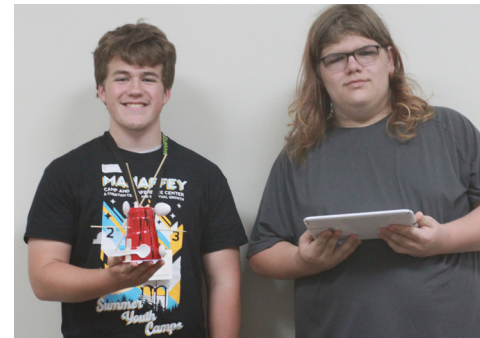
