It is always so encouraging to see family and friends reunited here every July. As a camp, we consider it a great honor to provide times of fellowship and discipleship so that you and your families can strengthen your relationships with one another and most importantly, with Christ. We trust that God has great things planned for all of us, as we seek to worship Him and know Him more during our time here together.

We have a great lineup of speakers and events planned. I encourage you to pick up a full schedule of events (located at the Welcome Center) so that you don't miss any of the services or activities. Be sure to also pick up the Mahaffey News as it is published throughout Family Camp, so that you keep up with the all the exciting things happening at camp (available at the Welcome Center and Dining Hall, and also published digitally on our Facebook page and website).

It takes many, many volunteers in order to facilitate Family Camp. Over 210 individuals are giving of their time and energy during this year's camp to volunteer in some capacity. Please join me in thanking them for their dedication!

Since we last met here for Family Camp in 2023, much has happened on our grounds. We have had incredible retreat seasons with full attendances in nearly every event. Academic Adventures hosted 8 events over the school year, with one event reaching 100 students – our largest attendance of the year. A brand-new retreat was added to the schedule this spring – Women's Leadership Retreat – which provided a wonderful time of growth for all the attendees. REPLENISH brought in 166 teens and youth leaders, our largest number ever—and this year's retreat was one of the most spiritually powerful we've ever seen. God has been so good in providing for these ministries to happen.

As we have been preparing for your arrival, we have been working diligently to complete some renovations around the campground. Here are some projects we have recently completed in hopes of improving our grounds:

- Installation of a parking lot at the old Dorm 4 site. During Family Camp, this parking is designated for handicap use only. During other events and retreats, it will be used for Dorm 5 resident parking.
- Upgrades to the playground, with a new playset installed in memory of Ben Wallace by the Mark & Alynda Wallace family and friends.
- New stations added at the Creation Center, including a stovetop at the mud kitchen, mini car roadway, and boat.
- Main Tabernacle sheetrock installed and finished at the west front area
- Dining Hall drain collapse, repair and cement installation at delivery entrance
- Nine square outdoor unit installation

The Board of Directors also broke ground this spring on the Mini-Lodge project, which is continuing as funds are available. This new lodging will provide essential housing for the growth of our ministries. As many of our retreats continue to reach maximum attendance, the Mini-Lodge will allow us to bring in more attendees at these events, rather than having to turn people away. Additionally, it will provide us opportunity to connect with our church families and community groups who are looking for a fresh and welcoming place to host their retreats and conferences.

This will be the final time that I welcome you to Family Camp, as I will be retiring in December. It has been a joy to share twenty-four Family Camps with you as the Director/Developer of Mahaffey Camp, and I pray that the ministry here only continues to grow in the next chapter of Mahaffey Camp's history. I have great faith that God is not done working here. As Nancy and I complete our time in directorship, we want to share a heartfelt thank you for all the wonderful memories we've shared, the encouragement you've given us, and the prayerful support you've shown to us. In this bittersweet time, I pray that God is glorified in all that we do.

With excitement and gratitude, it is my honor to welcome you to Mahaffey Family Camp 2024!

MAHAFFEY CAMP CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

The ministry to children at Mahaffey Camp is coordinated so that each child will be reached and challenged in their spiritual walk with the Lord. All age levels participate in hands-on learning experiences throughout the daily activities. Developmentally-appropriate activities are planned for each age group of children, with adequate supervision. Please plan for children to participate with their designated age group.

A special reminder to all parents: In order to better protect the children on the campground, you are asked to please register your children, ages 2 through 12. Upon registration, each child will be given a wristband identifying their camp guardian and location. If you preregistered your children, their wristband has been prepared and is available at the first Children's Ministry meeting they attend. Children are asked to wear the wristband the entire time they are at camp. This will assist the ministry workers in the event that they need to find a parent/guardian or if a child gets lost on the campground. You can register your children at the first service they attend within the various children's ministry programs. Children ages 8 - 12 also need to register; however, they are not required to have a wristband. Please be sure your child knows the location (cottage#, dorm#, RV area and #, etc.) where you are staying and also an emergency phone number.

Parents: Please be sure to pick up a Children's Brochure from the Welcome Center or at one of the bulletin boards located throughout the camp. It contains pertinent information, especially the start times of the services as well as the pickup times. **Please note**: Parents who are choosing to pick up their children must be present 5 minutes prior to dismissal and meet their children under the tent. If you are not present, your child will be dismissed with all the other children.

First Aid services are provided here at the Camp located at the Welcome Center. This is on a limited basis when personnel are available. Nearby Urgent Care centers as well as Emergency Room services are located both in Punxsutawney and DuBois.

In the event of an emergency where an ambulance is required, please dial 911, providing the address of Mahaffey Camp, Rt. 219, Mahaffey, PA. Immediately then notify security, the first aid staff or the office personnel who will then enact the emergency medical response plan, to open the gate and direct the ambulance to your location. Please be prepared to provide your complete location including a cottage #, RV site# (west, north, east), Dorm# and room#. If you are staying at a cottage, please be sure that all occupants know what number it is. The after hours emergency number for first aid on call is 814-592-6814. Please only use this number in an emergency after hours.

Please help us keep the camp a beautiful and welcoming place. Parents, grandparents, and sponsors of youth here on the grounds, please be reminded that you will be held responsible for any damage or defacement of camp property caused by your teen or child. This includes graffiti in the rest rooms, dorms, tabernacles, etc. Your assistance in discussing this with the teens or children in your care will be greatly appreciated. Please explain the consequences of their unsolicited artwork and the extra expense it causes the camp to cover it up.
