## MAIN TAB SPEAKER REV. DR. SCOTT REAM

Rev. Dr. Scott Ream grew up as a farm boy in Western Pennsylvania. While studying Business Administration at college he experienced the call to full-time ministry. This pursuit of the Lord's call led him to obtain his Business degree from Messiah College and an M. Div. from Winebrenner Seminary.

Scott spent three years as Assistant Pastor at the C&MA church in Bowling Green, Ohio. Since then, Scott has served in various positions at Somerset Alliance Church. He currently serves the congregation as their lead pastor.

In 2016, Scott received his Doctor of Ministry from Alliance Theological Seminary where his dissertation research focused on defining factors of health and burnout among ministry leaders. Driven by his passion to see healthy leaders and using his research, Scott developed the nonprofit TMH (Total Ministry Health, Inc). TMH focuses on preventing burnout in ministry leaders and helps those in burnout to recover and return to effective ministry. TMH provides assessments, consulting, coaching, and training for ministry leaders. His work with pastors and missionaries has taken him to five of the seven continents to teach or encourage pastors and international workers.

Scott's greatest joy is his family. He and his wife, Missy, have been married twenty-nine years. Missy faithfully serves with Scott doing everything from changing diapers, to hosting events, to international travel. They have six children ranging in age from 12-25, one son-in-law, two daughters-in-law, and one spoiled rotten granddaughter.

Dr. Ream will be speaking during the morning services through Sat., July 27.
