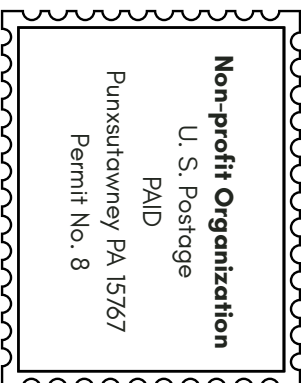

Departure: 2 PM on the final day of camp (Young Explorers conclude at 3 PM)

Recognition Programs: are held for Young Explorers, Horse, and Basketball camps.

MAHAFFEY CAMP CELL PHONE POLICY – APPLICABLE TO ALL CAMPS

To promote a distraction-free environment where campers can build friendships, grow spiritually, and fully engage in the camp experience, we strongly encourage parents not to send cell phones with their campers.

If a camper does bring a phone to camp, it must be turned in during registration and will be held securely at the office throughout the week.

Daily Access:

Campers will be given their phones for a designated “Phone Time” each day—30 minutes after lunch—to contact parents or send texts.

Special Requests:

Campers may request additional access to their phones during regular office hours if needed due to special circumstances.

Parents/guardians are always welcome to call the office during business hours to schedule a conversation with their child.

Emergencies:

In the event of an emergency, all counselors and staff are equipped with cell phones. Parents may contact the camp office directly at 814-277-5544. For after-hours emergencies, the Executive Director’s phone number will be made available.

CAMPER SAFETY

- 😓 **Report all injuries or sickness** to the Camp Nurse — don’t tough it out!
- 💊 **Turn in all medications** to the Nurse at registration.

- 🚪 **Campers may not leave the camp** without the Camp Dean’s permission.

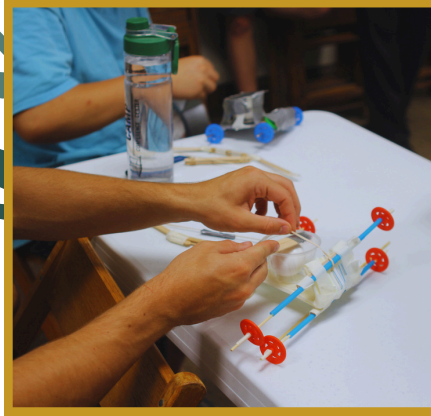

Permission is granted to contact our family doctor. I also authorize the release of any medical information necessary for insurance purposes to Mahaffey Camp and Conference Center. Mahaffey Camp and Conference Center and/or the Western PA District of the C&MA will be in no way held responsible for medical treatment or liability resulting from health or physical conditions existing before the camper's time at camp. It is understood that caution will be taken to prevent injury. I acknowledge that camp activities inherently carry risks that no amount of care, caution, instruction, or expertise can eliminate. We and the participant expressly and voluntarily assume all risk of personal injury sustained while participating in the aforementioned camp activities, whether or not caused by the negligence of the released parties, including but not limited to: sickness, bodily injury, death, emotional injury, personal injury, property damage, and financial damage. In the event of an accident, injury, or claim resulting from sickness (including claims related to the spread of infectious diseases), none of the following shall be held responsible: Camp Director, Nurse, any other camp staff or volunteer, Mahaffey Camp and Conference Center, or the Western PA District of the Christian and Missionary Alliance.
